OPERATOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Did you know that there are scholarships available to help operators with continuing education?

MWEA has two need-based \$500 scholarships available annually to cover expenses associated with training and education for wastewater operators. Members of MWEA and MSAWWA will be given preference.

MSAWWA has two \$500 scholarships or one \$1,000 scholarship available annually for covering expenses associated with training and education for water operators. The scholarship recipient will also receive a 1-year membership to AWWA, which provides further access to training materials.
